

#### Universities united for the best Horizon Europe

In the wake of the European Commission's release of its outline for the Ninth Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (Horizon Europe), 14 European associations representing universities united to respond to the proposal. For universities, creating the best Horizon Europe possible is paramount as the programme is a key enabler in achieving European ambitions and strengthening values. By reinforcing research and innovation, Horizon Europe will impact the daily life of European citizens, European society as a whole and the European economy.

## JOINING FORCES FOR HORIZON EUROPE 2020-2027

We therefore ask the European Parliament and the Council to support Horizon Europe and to incorporate the following necessary changes in order to ensure that it will fulfil the EU's ambitions:

- Increase the total budget.
- Review the budget allocation.
- Put the realisation of the European Research Area at the centre of Horizon Europe across all pillars.
- Foresee better linkages between research, innovation and education.
- Include a human and societal reflection, as well as options for fundamental research, in all clusters and missions.

- Cooperation offer from the ROSE Network Research on Societies in Europe
- A new initiative established only in Feb. 2018 at the University of Mainz but very active
- Target group: EU liaison officers at German Universities
- Major goals are to contribute to the creation of the future framework program for research and innovation – Horizon Europe and strengthen the role of SSH in national and European research agendas
- Recommendations on next FP9 (June 2018) & organised related workshop in Brussels with EC representatives (September)
- Common grounds Impact of Social Sciences in the broad perspective science policies and programmes addressing citizens' concerns in line with UNICA's conference on "Shaping the social impact of European research and with the seminar on "Research Policies & Urban Challenges"
