Biggest successes



2002 Seminar triggered the launch of a study by the European Commission on the publication markets, published 2006 – starting point of the EC Open Access policy actions



Challenges



Average number of participating universities	17
Average number of participants	50 (31-80)
Regular participating universities : 5 to 8 seminars	13
Occasional participating universities : 3 or 4 seminars	10
Exceptional participating universities : 1 or 2 seminars	9
Never participating universities	13
Universities participating at least one time	70%

Decreasing number of participating universities since 2010

Suggestions



- Address Open Science issues, including research data management, Open Access publishing
- Identify directors of libraries, heads of research support, directors of University Press in all UNICA member universities – with help of UNICA Secretariat through UNICA contact person?
- **Take advantage of UNICA as a network of universities : do what library associations don't**

Strengths of UNICA



- Focus on experience sharing - workshops rather than a big event on scholarly communication
- Mix participants from different departments in the universities facing Open Science issues:
 - Research administration department
 - Doctoral training...

Suggestions – plan for the future



Workshop with the EU research officers WG:

- Concerned by EU open access and open science policies
- Share experience on collaboration between libraries and research administration to support researchers in complying with EU Open Science requirements

Eg: open access to publications, OpenAIRE, Data Management Plan, FAIR research data management, open data...

Suggestions – plan for the future



Master class with the Doctoral education WG:

- Concerned by doctoral training on Open Science practices
- Share experience on, or build, an Open Science training programme in collaboration with libraries

Eg: awareness raising and developing skills on open access to publications, OpenAIRE, Data Management Plan, FAIR research data management, open data...
